- 6 Advance public health and prevent disease
- 7 Use health resources responsibly
- 8 Serve as an essential health resource

Profession

- 9 Ensure that I am competent
- 10 Act with honesty and integrity
- 11 Demonstrate responsibility for self and other health professionals
